



Certified Aires Terms and Conditions

CAMpRA Rally Group Certified Aires are for the benefit of members of the CAMpRA Rally Group. Membership of the CAMpRA Rally Group is free by joining the CAMpRA Rally Group Facebook page, or by staying overnight at one of our Rallies or Aires. By joining the group you agree to abide by the Code of Conduct which can be found on the CAMpRA Rally Group web site: <https://www.camprarally.org.uk>

This Certificate is valid providing the following conditions are met:

1. The certificate holder is responsible for all aspects of the site, its upkeep and management.

The extent of CAMpRA Rally Group involvement is for the planning exemption only. All aspects of the running of the site and the safety of the site's visitors are outside CAMpRA Rally Group control.

CAMpRA Rally Group accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to persons or property arising from the use of a CAMpRA Rally Group Certified Aire.

2. Prior to opening and then annually on renewal, the Certificate Holder must provide evidence of Public Liability Insurance. The policies must indicate the use of the land as a motorcaravan site and have a provision of a minimum £1m public liability.
3. Not more than FIVE motorcaravans are to be stationed on the land at any one time.
4. No Caravans, Trailer Tents or Tents.
5. No touring unit should be left UNOCCUPIED overnight at any time
6. No unit may stay more than 28 consecutive days at a time under the certificate. An Aire is intended to be for **short stay overnight parking with a maximum 48 hours**.
CAMpRA Rally Group issue certificates for use as an Aire not a campsite.
7. There must be no requirement for a minimum number of nights; one night stays must be allowed at all times.
8. Sub-letting of units is not permitted.
9. A continuous review of standards takes place, and an annual assessment will be carried out. Attention will be given to the condition and maintenance of the site, access and facilities where provided. These include drinking water supply, disposal of dry and liquid waste; provision of chemical disposal point and accompanying water supply.
10. This certificate does not legalise the storage of unoccupied units.
11. The Certified Aire may only operate on the specific area that has been agreed with CAMpRA Rally Group at the time of the application.
12. Once the certificate has been issued your site will be provided with a CAMpRA Rally Group Certified Aire sign to display at the entrance.
You will also get a free listing on the Searchforsites database used by over 350,000 members and your listing will include your CAMpRA Rally Group Accreditation.
You may also wish to add your site on other websites.

Subject to compliance with the above and details shown below the Certificate will be renewed annually.

ON SITE FACILITIES

We do not require mandatory facilities, however, if you supply facilities, they must be in accordance with the requirements set out below.

- If additional facilities are provided, the owner is responsible for ensuring appropriate planning permission has been obtained. Test certificates are required for electric hook ups.
- If providing water you should install a clearly marked drinking water supply installed in accordance with Water Authority requirements. If it is not a mains supply, a water quality test certificate must be obtained or a sign saying "Non drinking water" must be displayed.
- When providing a chemical disposal point, it requires to be a sealed system unless disposal is via mains drains and clearly marked.
- Any waste disposal needs to be provided in agreement with your local Environmental Health Officer and Planning Officer.
- A separate clearly marked water supply that should be situated near your chemical disposal point, as this is a requirement for the cleaning of chemical toilet cassettes. This must be installed in accordance with Water Authority requirements and clearly marked as "non drinking water".
- If providing facilities for disposal of litter this should be via an on-site collection point for dry waste. A dustbin with an attached lid is suitable for this purpose and must be emptied at least once a week or more often if necessary.
- All facilities must be regularly cleaned and maintained to avoid health hazards.
- To provide an onsite Emergency Notice Board or Welcome Pack containing important contacts
RESPONSIBILITIES AND UNDERTAKINGS. For example, setting appropriate speed limits, fires, dogs on leads etc. This list is not exhaustive, it is your responsibility to assess risk and provide instructions to your visitors to ensure the safety of all on-site.

THE SITE OWNER'S/OPERATOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide and maintain all facilities on site to a suitable standard, especially with regard to the safety and security of all.
- Ensure all units are pitched properly with adequate spacing between units, the guidance for a campsite is 6m. However our risk assessment, (available to download), recommends 3m. The applicant may wish to check with their local fire department if they intend to reduce the spacing from the standard 6m.
- Ensure that any other camping activities on your property, such as Rallies or Temporary Holiday Sites, are on clearly separate areas of land.
- To ensure that electrical hook-ups and water supplies (if applicable) are tested in accordance with the appropriate authorities and industry guidance.
- Never to permit a motorcaravan to remain on site for longer than 28 consecutive days.
- Not operate any other form of campsite in the same area allocated for the Certified Aire.
- Seasonal pitches are not permitted on the land designated as the Certified Aire.
- CAMpRA Rally Group advise not to take advanced bookings other than a check of availability 24 hours in advance. Should you decide for operational reasons to take bookings in advance you must make unbooked pitches available for use.
- To notify the Group of any change of ownership or closure.
- To notify the Group of any change to details that may affect the site or its operation.
- To notify the Group of any amendments required to your site listing on the Searchforsites website such as, contact details, symbols, fees and directions.
- Understand that the CAMpRA Rally Group and Searchforsites permit individual site reviews online for public viewing.
- The use of Yurts, Tepees, Camping Pods and other similar unit types are strictly forbidden on land certified as an Aire
CAMpRA Rally Group certify for motorcaravans only.
- The parking area must be kept clear of any machinery, chemicals or additional hazards to humans and their pets.
- Attention should be regularly given to safe access and suitable signage of the site.
- The use of the site should not cause inconvenience to users or local residents.
- Vehicle speed must be kept to 5mph at all times.
- Dogs and other pets must be kept under their personal control at all times.
- Children must be under supervision at all times.

CAMpRA Rally Group retains the right to revoke the site certification without notice or explanation.
